





Trade Secret - Gaining and Losing Protection

Must be the subject of <u>reasonable efforts</u> <u>to maintain secrecy</u>

- What's reasonable depends on the circumstances and how valuable the secret is.
- Might include:
 - Locks, fences, security guards, password protection, firewalls
 - Limiting the number of people who know
 - Splitting up knowledge among different people
 - Employee contracts, non-disclosure agreements, non-compete agreements
